

Resource files

- step 1 convert your image to grayscale
 use Image > Mode > Grayscale

- step 2 adjust contrast
 use Image > Adjustments > Levels

Open connections.psd file

- step 1 use selection tool on the tool bar to select a section of one of your files
 use Edit > Copy or Command + C

- step 2 switch to the connections.psd and use selection tool to select one of the square
 paste into the selection square by
 using Edit > Paste Into
 a new layer will be created

- step 3 adjust image
 use Edit > Free Transform
 the pasted-in image can be moved about, rotated, and scaled (hold shift key to lock proportions)

Show the grid

- step 1 show the grid
 View > Show > Grid

- step 2 & set the size
 Photoshop > Preferences > Guides, Grids, & Slices

Repeat with additional images finding connections

Move squares around if needed

- use the Move Tool, first tool on the tool bar
- make sure the correct layer is selected
