5. **TERMINATION.** This contract may be terminated at no cost to either party upon 5 days advance written notice.

6. **OTHER.** The Speaker is an independent contractor and will pay all applicable state, local and federal taxes associated with this agreement. This Agreement is the complete & exclusive understanding of the parties, and may only be modified in writing with the agreement of both parties. Time is of the essence in this agreement. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Indiana. Any dispute arising hereunder shall be resolved exclusively in the courts of the state of Indiana located in St. Joseph County, Indiana.
