Uday Bhawalkar is one of the leading and most talented singers of “dhrupad”, the most ancient style of North Indian classical music which still survives in its original form. He is following the glorious tradition of musicians like Zia Mohiuddin Dagar, Zia Fariduddin Dagar (who are both his teachers), and of the older Dagar Brothers. He has received many honors and prizes, including the prestigious Young Musicians' Award of the Indian Ministry of Culture, and has performed outside India since the mid-80s. He has appeared, for instance, at the Sangeet Parampara Festival in Berlin, the World Music Festival in Switzerland, the Raga Mala in Seattle in the USA and at the Queen Elizabeth Hall in London. He has also sung in a number of Indian and international films.
