

The O'Meara Mathematics Library staff are pleased to announce that starting on Sunday, September 11, a mathematics tutor will be available in the O'Meara Mathematics Library (lower level of Hayes-Healy). Tutors are available from Sundays thru Thursdays, 7pm – 11pm.

Tutors are available to help *\*any\** student (undergraduate or graduate) who's having trouble with any sort of mathematics. There is no cost to the student. The tutors are either graduate students or senior honors majors of the Mathematics Department.

Tutoring can be scheduled for an individual or a small group for half-hour sessions. Interested students can email ([mathlib.1@nd.edu](mailto:mathlib.1@nd.edu)) or phone (631-7278) the O'Meara Mathematics Library to schedule a time. If a time is arranged in advance there will be a better chance of getting help at the time needed. The tutors will also accommodate drop-in students.

When scheduling, students will be asked to provide their names, their major, and the name of their class. It would also be help to explain briefly what sort of help they're looking for. Specifics will give the tutor time to prepare in advance of the session.

Tutors are available to help with assignments or questions, not to do homework or repeat lectures that students missed.
