Day 1 Monday, May 22: Depart USA

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport via Iberia Airlines for the overnight transatlantic flight to Lisbon, Portugal. Dinner, breakfast, and beverages will be served in flight. (D)

Day 2 Tuesday, May 23: Arrive in Lisbon | Fatima

Early afternoon arrive at Lisbon International Airport. Go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our private coach bus and we will be on our way to Lisbon for an orientation tour of this beautiful Portuguese city. Visit the Church of St. Anthony, where in 1195, St. Anthony of Padua, patron saint of Portugal, was born. Stroll through the old quarter to visit the cathedral, housing St. Anthony's baptismal font. Pass by the Belem Quarter, Belem Tower, 25 April Bridge, the Discoveries Monument, and St. Jerome Monastery. Next, we'll continue on to Fatima, where the Blessed Mother appeared in 1917 to three shepherd children and urged mankind to pray for world peace. Check-in at our hotel in Fatima.

After a group dinner, you'll have the option to attend the 9:30 p.m. Rosary in the Chapel of the Apparitions, followed by Eucharistic Candlelight Procession.

Overnight at our hotel in Fatima. (B,D)

Day 3 Wednesday, May 24: Fatima | Valinhos | Aljustrel

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, our guide will take us on a tour of the Shrine of Fatima. In May 1917, Our Lady was seen several times by three shepherd children—Jacinta, Francisco, and Lucia—at Cova da Iria, where the basilica now stands. Visit the tombs of the children and the Chapel of the Apparitions, known as the Capelinha. Continue on to visit Aljustrel, the hamlet where the three children lived, and view their untouched homes. Visit Valinhos where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison. "O My Jesus, Forgive us Our Sins, save us from the Fires of Hell, lead all Souls to Heaven, especially those most in need of Thy Mercy." Follow the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) built by Hungarian refugees, which culminates in the Chapel of Calvary, overlooking all of Fatima. Finally, visit the church where the children were baptized. Independent lunch.

Afternoon concert at the basilica in Fatima, presented by the University of Notre Dame Chorale.

After a group dinner, you'll have the option to attend the 9:30 p.m. Rosary in the Chapel of the Apparitions, followed by Eucharistic Candlelight Procession.

Overnight at our hotel in Fatima. (B,D)

Day 4 Thursday, May 25: Fatima | Salamanca | Ávila

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Fatima and drive to Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage City, known both for its monumental sights and its great university. Various religious orders have always been attracted to this city, including the Dominican Order of St. Stephen's Convent, the Jesuit Order with its monumental college, and the Discalced Carmelites Order. Independent lunch in Salamanca.

After lunch, we'll continue to Ávila, the City of Kings and of Saints that is completely encircled by 11th century walls. They contribute to the defining image of the warring and monastic center that Ávila has been able to maintain throughout the years. Check-in at our hotel.

Evening concert at the Church of San Juan Bautista, presented by the University of Notre Dame Chorale.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Ávila. (B,D)

Day 5 Friday, May 26: Ávila | El Escorial Monastery

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll tour the city of Ávila. Visit the place where St. Teresa was born and baptized. Tour St. Vincent's Church, one of the most monumental complexes of Ávila. Continue to visit the cathedral, which contains many relics of St. Teresa, and the Convento of La Santa, built on the site of her birthplace and home to a comprehensive museum dedicated to her life. Continue on to the Convent of La Encarnación, where St. Teresa became a Carmelite. Visit the Chapel of Transverberation, meaning "Stigmata of the Heart." We'll visit the convent of San Jose, a monastery of Discalced Carmelite Nuns that was the first monastery founded by St. Teresa. Independent lunch in Ávila.

After lunch, we'll visit the world-famous El Escorial Monastery and San Lorenzo

del Escorial, the burial place of Spanish kings and queens. Philip II built this monastery as a memorial for his father, Charles V. The church itself is in the shape of a Greek cross.

Afternoon informal concert at El Escorial Monastery, presented by the University of Notre Dame Chorale (*subject to confirmation*). Return to Ávila. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Ávila. (B,D)

Day 6 Saturday, May 27: Ávila | Segovia | Madrid

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll leave Ávila to visit Old Castile and the magnificent medieval city of Segovia. Our brief stop at Vera Cruz, just outside the town of Segovia, will give us a superb view of the romantic Alcazar fortress of the great Queen Isabella. Upon arrival, our local guide will take us on a walking tour of the grounds, including the undamaged Roman Aqueduct, still in use today and recognized as one of the best-preserved Roman remains. Walk through the Jewish quarter to Segovia's 16th century cathedral, one of the finest in Spain. The ancient, crooked streets of Segovia are noted for the picturesque Romanesque churches, untouched for six centuries. Visit the romantic Alcázar, the palace of the great Queen Isabella. Originally a fortress, the Alcázar has also been a royal palace, the site of Philip II's wedding to his fourth wife, Anne of Austria, and more recently a military academy. Independent lunch.

Possible 20-minute informal concert at the cathedral in Segovia. Late afternoon, we'll continue to Madrid for hotel check-in.

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Madrid.

Day 7 Sunday, May 28: Toledo

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll leave Madrid to visit Toledo. Toledo is like a living national monument, depicting all the elements of Spanish civilization in hand-carved, sun-mellowed stone. Set on a hill overlooking the Tagus River, this ancient city is a fascinating architectural blend of Christian and Moorish elements, especially rich in buildings from the late 15th and 16th centuries. Upon arrival, we'll visit the 13th century cathedral. Somber but elaborate, it is blazing with jeweled chalices, gorgeous ecclesiastical vestments, hundreds of historic tapestries, 750 stained-glass windows, and art by Tintoretto, Titian, Murillo, El Greco, Velasquez, and Goya. By taking the Travesía de los Descalzos, we'll reach the Plaza del Conde, where the Fuensalida Palace is located. Built by the first Fuensalida Count, Don Pedro López de Ayala, it is today the seat of the regional government. Independent lunch in Toledo.

After lunch, we'll visit the Jewish Quarter. Without a doubt, it is the eastern part of the Jewish Quarter that attracts the most tourists. It starts on Paseo de San Cristóbal Boulevard, from which you can see unique buildings like the Tránsito Synagogue, El Greco's House and Museum, and other Mudejar-style buildings. In the square you can also visit the Iglesia de Santo Tomé, where one of El Greco's most famous paintings resides, "El Entierro del Conde de Orgaz" (The Burial of the Count of Orgaz).

Concert presentation at Inglesia de Santo Tomé, presented by the University of Notre Dame Chorale (subject to confirmation). Return to Madrid.

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Madrid. (B)

Day 8 Monday, May 29: Prado Museum | Royal Palace

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll begin our day with a visit to the Prado Museum, justly famous as one of the world's richest for its spectacular collection of paintings, including the incomparable works of El Greco, Velásquez, Murillo, and Goya. Thanks to the extraordinary taste and acquisitiveness of Charles V, Philip II, and Philip IV, along with Spanish artists, the Prado is also rich in the works of Italian and Flemish masters, including Titian, Raphael, Botticelli, Fraq Angelico, Veronese, Tintoretto, Rubens, Van Dyck, Breughel, and Bosch. Independent lunch.

We'll visit the Royal Palace, built for Spain's royalty in the 18th century. (The Royal Palace can be closed unexpectedly for official celebrations). King Felipe VI and Queen Letizia continue to use it today for many state functions. The surrounding area is one of the most beautiful palatial complexes in all Europe. Evening concert at the Basilica of San Miguel or the Church of San Emanuel e Benito, presented by the University of Notre Dame Chorale (subject to confirmation).

Farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Madrid. (B,D)

Day 9 Tuesday, May 30: Return to the USA

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Madrid Airport for our return flight to the USA. Arrive on the same day. (B)

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel. Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies.
