Founded in 1915, the Notre Dame Men's Glee Club gives dozens of concerts on campus and on tour each year, presenting a mixture of sacred and secular classical a cappella music for men's chorus as well as spirituals and folk and popular music. They have appeared in over 40 of the 50 USA states, and on their international tours they have performed throughout Europe (most recently in 2015) and in Latin America, Asia, and the Middle East.

Tour highlights have included orchestral appearances in Jerusalem and Hong Kong, as well as a pilgrimage along the Camino de Santiago in Spain in 2013, with concerts in Burgos, León, Santiago de Compostela, and Salamanca Cathedrals.

The newest of many Glee Club recordings are *On the Rocky Road to Dublin* (2012) and *Loyal Sons* (2016).







The Notre Dame Symphony Orchestra, in its 85th year, draws its membership from all courses of study at the university. They present orchestral repertoire from the 18th to the 21st century in three annual campus concerts; recent tours have included performances in California, Florida, Canada, and Guatemala, and at New York's Carnegie Hall. In May and June of 2017 the orchestra will take their first European tour, joining with the Glee Club for concerts in Poland, Germany, and the Czech Republic.
