Robert (Bob) H. Bishop, Dean, Marquette University, USA

Dr. Robert H. Bishop is the Dean of Engineering at Marquette University and holds a faculty position in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering. He holds the Opus Endowed Chair. Previously, he held the position of Chairman of the Department of Aerospace Engineering and Engineering Mechanics at The University of Texas at Austin where he held the Joe J. King Professorship and was a Distinguished Teaching Professor. Prior to academia, he was a member of the technical staff at the MIT Charles Stark Draper Laboratory. Dr. Bishop is a specialist in the area of systems theory, guidance and control of aerospace vehicles, and navigation and estimation theory with applications across a broad range of global challenges. Dr. Bishop is a Fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics and a Fellow of the American Astronautical Association.
