



Tuncay Döğeroğlu, Dean, Anadolu University, Turkey

Dr. Tuncay Döğeroğlu received her B.Sc. in chemical engineering in 1985 and Ph.D. in chemical engineering in 1993 from Anadolu University. She served as a teaching assistant from 1986-1993 in the Chemical Engineering Department at the university. In 1994, she joined the Environmental Engineering Department there. She became the Vice Dean of the Faculty of Engineering and Architecture in and then Dean of the Faculty of Engineering in 2010.

Dogeroglu's areas of professional expertise include air pollution, as she has co-authored more than a hundred of publications on air quality and environmental pollution topics. She was an (International Center for Theoretical Physics (ICTP) Scholar at CNR Air Pollution Institute in Rome during 2000-2001. She is an Associate Member of ICTP (2006-2011).

Currently, she is an Executive Committee Member of the Global Engineering Deans Council (GEDC) (since October 2011) and an Officer of the GEDC (since October 2012), an Executive Board Member of Turkish Society for Quality Eskisehir Branch (since 2007), and a Commission Member of National Qualifications Framework Working Group of Turkish Higher Educational Council. She has also served as a Member of the Board of Academic Assessment and Quality Improvement at University since 2007.
