Dr. Peter Jimack has served as Dean of the Faculty of Engineering at the University of Leeds since August 2010. Leeds is one of the largest Universities in the UK and, as such, has one of the largest engineering colleges, with more schools.

Peter's academic background is in computational science and engineering, and he holds the post of Professor of Scientific Computing, within the School of Computing. His research interests focus on the development and application of fast and efficient numerical algorithms for engineering problems, particularly those involving fluid flows.

As Dean, he is keen to grow international partnerships for the university, in engineering and beyond, and to contribute to the global agenda in engineering education. He also promotes strong engagement with industry at all levels, from influencing the undergraduate curriculum through to undertaking applied research and knowledge transfer.
