Joint Ph.D. Program

- Students can enroll in the program either at IITM or MSU
- Admitting institution's rules prevail
- At least one year stay required in the partnering institution
- Advisors at both institutions
- Research topic chosen on the basis of mutual interest
- Two diplomas

Research Topics

 - Pathogen detection
 - Treatment
- Energy
 - Biofuels
 - Thermoelectrics

Undergraduate Summer Internship Program

- 10 week summer program
- Hosting institution covers cost of room and board
- NSF/DST funded
- MSU provides \$4,400 to cover costs of room, board and incidentals for visiting students

Pre-visit Message
