The purpose of this seminar is to introduce undergraduates to General Topology, a topic in higher mathematics accessible to first and second year Honors Mathematics students. Topology is interesting in its own right, but it will prove quite useful in upper level mathematics courses and in graduate work in the mathematically related sciences. The seminar requires work, but not as much work as an Honors Mathematics course.

Students in Mathematics 10860 or 20860 or 20820 can join this seminar. Initially all of the lectures will be given by Professor Frank Connolly. Later students will present some of the material. The seminar will begin with metric topology, a subject with a strong intuitive underpinning.
