

Purchasing Book/Homework Access For this class, we ask that you purchase the **Cengage Unlimited** (\$134.99 at the bookstore, 4 month) option (ISBN: 9780357700006). Cengage Unlimited gives you access to online homework and e-book for this course. With Cengage Unlimited, you can also rent a hard copy of the textbook – but this is strictly optional.

Creating your WebAssign account

- After you have purchased your Cengage package and have your personal code, then either
 - go to the [Webassign GetEnrolled page](#) (if you have the pdf version of this document, available on the webpage, then just click on this link), or:
 - go to this page: <http://www.webassign.net> and click on **Enter a Class Key** on the upper right of the page.
- Enter the appropriate Class Key from the table below and click **Enroll**:

- Follow the directions to your existing account (if you have one), or click on the **Create Account** and create a new Cengage account (it's best to use your e-mail address as your username and keep a record of your password).

Getting Started You will now be able to view your Home Page on WebAssign, which will give you a list of current assignments; in particular, you can start work on your homework. You will notice two assignments that provide an introduction to WebAssign. These are optional and are non-credit assignments. If this is the first time you've used WebAssign we recommend you take some time before the beginning of the semester to familiarize yourself with the platform.

Your Home Page also offers a window with information on the e-book. You can preview the e-book and the attached media files if you click on this window.

Homework will be assigned daily and done electronically through WebAssign. See the WebAssign page for the daily assignments.
