

How to hand in your final exam

Your final exam is due by the end of day on December 13, which is the Monday of exam week. The exam will consist of your My Philosophy answers since the midterm exam (so, including everything other than the sections on God and free will and any puzzle questions generated by your answers on those sections).

To hand in your My Philosophy page, follow these steps:

- (1) Log into your My Philosophy page **using Chrome or Safari on a Mac computer**. The procedure below will not work on a Windows machine or on a mobile device. Macs are available to use at various locations on campus.
- (2) Click on the button on the right hand side that says “printable version.”
- (3) Click command-P to print the page.
- (4) When the print dialogue comes up, chose the option “save to PDF.”
- (5) Email the PDF to your TA.

The PDF will have your netID on the front page.

If you have questions, post them to the ‘ask a prof’ channel on Slack, so that all can see the answer.

Don’t panic if you can’t get this to work; in a worse case scenario, I can generate the PDF for you if you send me your nedID and password.
