LAWYERS ALUMNI COMMITTEE CHARTER STATEMENT

The name of this committee of the Notre Dame Club of Detroit (the “Club”) shall be the Notre Dame Lawyers Alumni Committee (the “Committee”). The purpose of the Committee is to promote the mission, objectives, and activities of the University of Notre Dame (“UND”), the Notre Dame Alumni Association (“NDAA”), Notre Dame Law School (“NDLS”) and the Notre Dame Law Association (“NDLA”) as related to the legal profession in Southeastern Michigan by:

- (i) encouraging, fostering, and promoting the interest and participation of lawyers to become and remain Club members, and to involve themselves in the various Club and Committee activities;
- (ii) promoting professional development and advancing the highest principles of ethics and professionalism among members, prospective members, and the bar generally;
- (iii) providing a forum for networking and cultivating a spirit of cooperation, camaraderie and support among all ND alums who are in the legal profession; and
- (iv) encouraging and assisting students and alums of UND and NDLS in pursuing careers in the legal profession within the Detroit region, especially for positions located within or near the geographic boundaries of the Club. To this end, the Committee will provide an organized and accessible legal network for ND Law students and lawyer alums of NDLS and/or UND for networking, programming, employment opportunities and support.

Any member of the Club who is (i) a graduate of NDLS, and/or (ii) a graduate of UND, with a law degree from any accredited law school or enrolled in an accredited law school and residing in Southeastern Michigan, shall be considered eligible to become a member of the Committee. The Committee shall be co-chaired by two Committee members appointed by the President of the Club. At least one of the co-chairs will be a member of the Board of Directors of the Club; at least one will hold an undergraduate degree from UND; and at least one will hold a law degree from NDLS. Committee leadership shall serve for a one-year term, subject to renewal and/or re-appointment by the President of the Club; and Committee leaders will serve at the pleasure of the President of the Club. The Committee will be responsible to, and overseen by, the Board of Directors of the Club. A roll of the members and potential members of the Committee shall be prepared, maintained, and periodically updated from the records of the NDAA, the NDLA and the Club.
